


RESTORATIVE JUSTICE

This unique program allows victims of crime to participate fully in the resolution of the offense – with a focus on accountability, seeking solutions, and making amends.

Restorative Justice practices are centered on making things right for all parties involved while enabling creative solutions not used within the traditional justice system.



Our model is integrated into 19 Jefferson County Public Schools and used in circuit courts, district courts, DJJ programs with youth, and schools. We are beginning to explore a partnership with Ben Wilcox and the school resource officers.

- Significant cost savings for every case resolved outside the court system
- Healing and restoration for victims and community
- 50% reduction in recidivism compared to those who do not get this intervention
